Capturing Kids Hearts – PRIDE Promises

Last week, we provided an overview about the Capturing Kids Hearts system, and this week we will examine a key component of CKH: PRIDE Promises. Also known as Social Contracts, PRIDE Promises are a way that each classroom gets to describe how they want their learning environment to look and feel (we also do one as a staff for our entire school). Students are asked questions such as “How do you want to be treated by me (teacher)?”; “How do you want to be treated by each other?”; “How do you think I (teacher) want to be treated by you?” and “How do you want to treat each other when there is conflict?” Students and teachers then talk about respect and ideas that create buy-in and drive each classroom forward. We are constantly referring to our PRIDE Promises at CES, and they are very helpful to our entire culture.
