Important Distance Learning Information:

- The returning of completed packets **and** the passing out of all K-5 packets will now take place on Fridays at CES from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and at the Cory Store from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Distance Learning through CES – May 1st

- Our School District has cancelled in-person schooling for the remainder of this year. We will continue with our Distance Learning model.
- We will continue to create packets, with Friday, May 8th being the final week for families to pickup the week of May 11th – 15th packets.
- All students who have turned in all their work by Friday, May 15th will be done with this academic school year. If students are missing work at that time, teachers will work with students and families the week of May 18th – 22nd to have all missing work turned in by May 22nd. **Per our school district's request we will be accepting work until May 29th, however, with report cards sent out the following week.**
- Quarter 4 report cards will look a bit different this year – as they will have a narrative provided instead of typical grades. Please continue to work hard so teachers can offer an accurate, thorough narrative.
