### Update on Upcoming School Year

Superintendent Caryn Gibson recently sent a message to staff and this is an excerpt from her email:  
“Everyone is anxious to know about our plans for resuming school in the fall. The School District’s desire for the fall is to have all students and staff in traditional in-person (face-to-face) learning. The District has begun planning for how to provide the safest and best possible learning environments, or tracks, for the 2020-21 school year. While we do not yet know what school will look like in the fall, the District is preparing for three possibilities: Traditional, Hybrid (a blend of in-person and distance learning), and Distance/Online learning environments. We are doing extensive planning and will be creating a working group to advise and accommodate learning for the different approaches. We do understand the in-person option may not be a good fit for all this fall, therefore, we are working on providing an online option for families that do not want their students to return to school for health reasons... We continue to face many challenges as we look to resume school and student participation in the fall, but we face them with a positive attitude and perseverance.”  
There will be a survey coming out soon for the DO to gather information before proceeding. Please stay tuned.
